

## **2021 Snack Shop**

### **ISSUE:**

Prior to renewing the contract with the Snack Shack and based on community member interest in having the opportunity to provide alternatives, the board requested business proposals from LHCC association members interested in operating the Clubhouse Snack Shop for 2021, with the potential of a longer-term contract.

### **BACKGROUND:**

LHCC received three business plans by the January due date outlined in the initial request for proposals. The three interested parties were asked to present at the Feb. 3 Board of Directors meeting to answer questions and provide clarity on their respective proposals.

Two businesses attended the meeting to address the board's questions/concerns. At the meeting, the Board elected to hold-off on a vote, instead, a request for additional information was compiled and questions sent to each respondent requesting clarification and/or additional information by February 15. A follow-up meeting with each prospective business was scheduled for February 17 with President Traczyk and Director Melcher to provide an additional forum to exchange information.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Board members review the prospective responses to the questionnaire and document their thoughts on those responses.

President Traczyk and Director Melcher provide a report to the board based on the input received during the February 17 meetings.

### **SUMMARY:**

Consider business plans of interested LHCC association members and decide on which respondent provides the best use of the available space in the club house, best pricing, alternative food, and non-food options.

### **PROPOSED MOTION(S) or ACTION(S):**

Based on the input received from the interested parties, select the best food service option for the association members for calendar year 2021, and other optional years.
