Painting of Clubhouse Lower-Level

Background Issue:

Painting of the lower level of the clubhouse.

Background Information:

Due to the usage of the lower level of the clubhouse for multiple activities over the years, the need for a fresh coat of paint or two are needed for maintenance of the room. The operators of Munchie Duck Concessions requested that the Buildings and Grounds Committee have her paint the lower level. The committee concurred that the area needed to be painted and selected an approved color to past on to the Board. That color is a very light gray, that is similar to the off-white presently displayed on the walls.

Recommendation/Request:

After reviewing the request for the painting of the walls of the clubhouse lower level, the Buildings and Grounds Committee is recommending that the Board approve the project. Munchie Duck operators would be responsible for obtaining the materials, including paint, and doing the painting, to fit their Fall operational schedule. Munchie Duck would be repaid only for the cost of the paint, and up to no more than \$75 for supplemental supplies. The cost of the project would be taken from the clubhouse maintenance budget.

MOTION: That the Board authorize the painting of the lower level of the clubhouse by the Munchie Duck operators, in the light gray color selected. Supplemental supplies (brushes, rollers, pans) are not to exceed \$75 for reimbursement. The cost of the project would be extracted from the maintenance budget of refurbishing the clubhouse.
