### **2022 Fish Stocking – Not To Exceed \$15,000**

#### **ISSUE:**

In 2018 the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries (VDGIF) and the Lake Holiday (LH) fishing community had concerns with the continued decline of our smallmouth bass population. During the three (3) most recent VDGIF electroshock surveys in 2009, 2014 and 2017 we experienced a significant reduction in the number of smallmouth bass harvested through this process. The VDGIF survey showed that smallmouth bass comprised 50% of our black bass population in 2009, population totals declined to 29% in 2014, and during 2017, this total fell to 6%. We continue to have these same concerns in 2022. For this year's fish stocking, we have been in communication with Fender's Fish Hatchery. We won't receive final pricing until mid-to-late October.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Several factors have impacted the habitat/success of this specific fishery including the 10'-12' lake draw-down during dam construction and stocking of sterile grass carp. The grass carp eradicated the vegetative/grass cover necessary for the young. VDGIF and the LH fishing community are in agreement that lake draw down, stocking of grass carp, age/mortality rate of our larger/mature spawning class fish, limited/no cover for recruitment class fish and the inherent difficulties associated with smallmouth spawning have negatively impacted the smallmouth fishery at Lake Holiday.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Motion to approve release of the Replacement Reserve funds not to exceed \$15,000 for the fall 2022 Lake Committee Fish Stocking event. Event to be held the second week of November.

## **Virginia Fish Stocking Authorization**

(to stock fish in Virginia inland waters pursuant to 4VAC 15-320-60)

Virginia regulation (4VAC 15-320-60) requires authorization from the Department to stock any species of fish into inland waters of the state. This regulation, however, does not restrict stocking of native fish species into privately owned ponds. The purpose of this authorization requirement is to protect native populations of fish, to control spread of fish diseases, and to avoid establishment of exotic fish populations in streams where such species would be undesirable.

Enclosed is a authorization application. You are required to give the name of the supplier from whom you will be purchasing fish. When describing the section of stream to be stocked, please provide reliable landmarks (such as state highway crossings) that can be easily identified by Department staff. You are also required to provide a location map. For best results, use a copy of a USGS topographic map or a county Highway Department map. **DO NOT** write on the lines **AUTHORIZATION NO. AND EXPIRATION.**

When issued, this authorization will be good only for the stockings indicated on the application. In addition, an expiration date will be given, after which time, another authorization will be required. Any changes in the conditions listed on the authorization will require review by the biologist. The approved authorization must be available for inspection at the time of stocking.

The authorization will generally be processed within 15 days of receipt. Please forward the enclosed application or any inquiries to the appropriate Regional Fisheries Managers Office.

### Purpose of Form
